## Protecting Consumer Health

The standard sets limits on the use of harmful chemicals and substances in textile products to safeguard consumer health.

## Comprehensive Testing

Textiles and accessories are tested for a wide range of potentially harmful substances, including pesticides, heavy metals, formaldehyde, phthalates, and other chemical residues.

## Independent Certification

The certification is conducted by independent OEKO-TEX® member institutes, which assess the compliance of textile products based on standardised criteria.

## Global Recognition

OEKO-TEX® Standard 100 is recognised and accepted worldwide as a reliable label for safer and more sustainable textile products.

## Annual Renewal

OEKO-TEX® certification is valid for one year, and manufacturers and suppliers must undergo annual retesting and renewal to maintain compliance.
